GENERIC THEATER KIDS FREE HAMPTON ROADS



What is it?

Kids Free Hampton Roads is an initiative by the Generic Theater to bring the joy, excitement and entertainment of live theater to local drama students.

Why is it needed?

Generic Theater realized that though our area has a variety of arts opportunities, the costs for many citizens are prohibitive. To see a Broadway tour of a play can cost approximately \$500 for a family of 4. Tickets for community theaters generally run between \$15 and \$25 each. Shows at local professional theaters cost even more. Generic Theater wants to make sure that our next generation of thespians has the opportunity to

enjoy live theater at no cost. Kids Free Hampton Roads is our way of doing just that.

How does it work?

Any southside Hampton Roads high school drama student may attend for free the final dress rehearsal, also known as the IDR, for any Generic show. They need simply to present themselves at the Generic box office for any scheduled IDR and provide staff with the name of their school. This is for tracking purposes to evaluate the *Kids Free Hampton Roads* program. They will be admitted for free.

Where?

When?

IDRs are typically held at 8:00 PM on the Thursday evening the day before the official opening of each show. That is the performance to which area high school drama students are invited through *Kids Free Hampton Roads*. Because theater is live action, patrons are advised to arrive no later than 15 minutes before a show. Late comers may have to wait for a break between scenes to be seated so audiences and actors are not disturbed.
